Spring Break Mexico Mission Trip

Come with the Youth and Missions Team to San Miguel Mexico to work on the orphanages. We have already taken two trips to San Miguel and they were extremely worthwhile. Below is the information. If you have further questions contact David Johnson, Jeremy Graham or Greg & Edna Thompson. We need to know by Thursday, December 31, if you are planning on going. A \$50 deposit is also required at this time.

Details:

We will leave on Friday, March 12, and return on Thursday, March 18. We will fly to Dallas and then to Leon, Mexico. Leon is in Central Mexico in the state of Guanajuato. The work will be on the grounds of the boys orphanage. It will consist of rock and tree removal. There will be equipment already there to assist us. We will also visit the two girls orphanages so that you are familiar with all three that we are supporting. There will be plenty of time in the evenings to visit stores and local shopping.

Cost:

\$800 per person. This includes air fare, transportation, lodging & food. There are special youth scholarships available on a limited basis.

Safety Issues:

San Miguel is very safe. It is in central Mexico. Most problems in Mexico are around the border. San Miguel has many internationals that come because of the year round climate. We have not had a single incident either time we have been. It is safe to be on the streets in the evening. The town square, or de jardin, is a gathering place in the evenings for locals and tourist alike.

Itinerary:

Friday, March 12 – Fly to Leon and take bus to San Miguel

Saturday, March 13 – Work day

Sunday, March 14 – Morning worship. In the afternoon we will take the orphans swimming.

Monday, March 15 – Wednesday, March 17 – Work days.

Thursday, March 18 – Return Home.

Other:

You will have to have a passport.

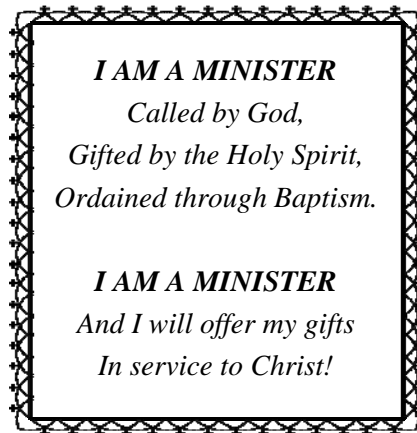
