During confirmation class, confirmands learn about the meaning of Christian faith; the history and teachings of the United Methodist Church; and an explanation of the baptismal and membership vows they will be professing. All children in 6th grade (or older youth who have not gone through confirmation) are encouraged to attend Confirmation 2010 beginning **TODAY, February 21, from 5:30pm-7:00pm**.
