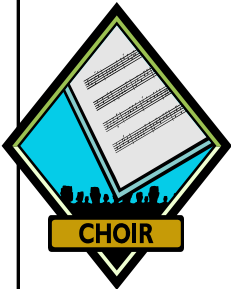

## Child S.H.A.R.E. Christmas Party Gifts Needed

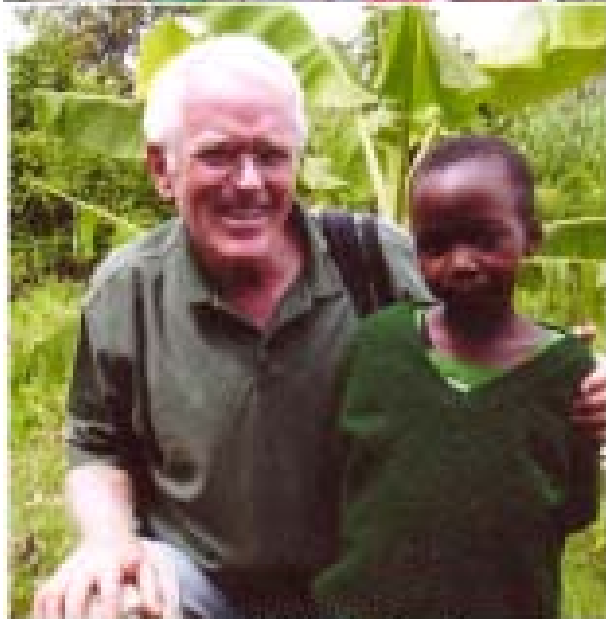
