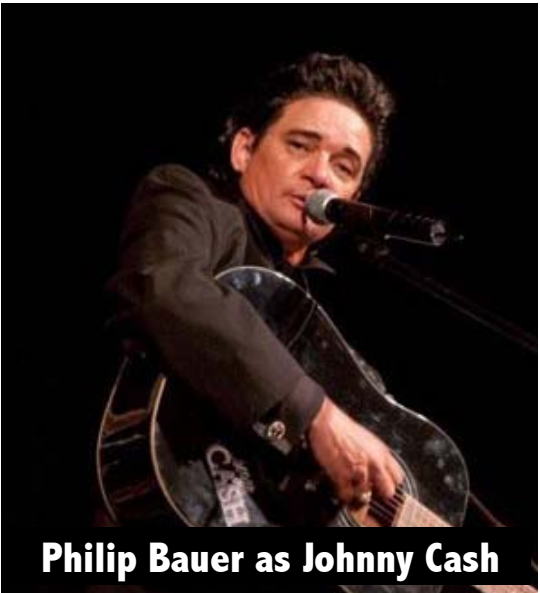

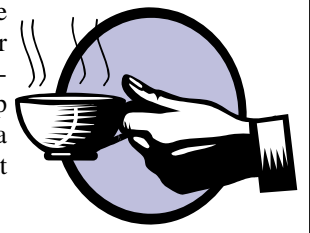
Confirmation 2011

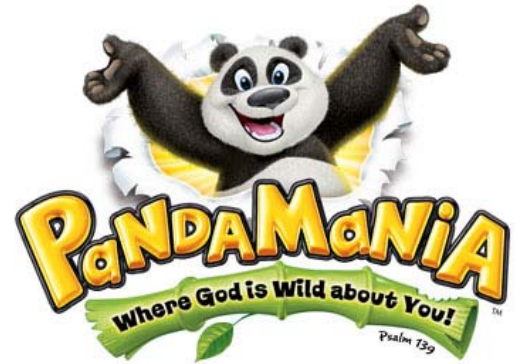

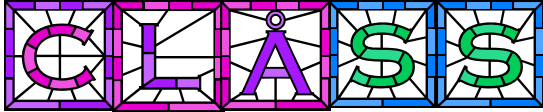

"We are Javier and Genny Cruz. We are nondenominational Christians committed to bringing the word of God to homes where the Spirit of God guides us. Our mission is in San Miguel de Allende but we have experience in other states such as Quintana Roo, Yucatan, Campeche, Chiapas and Tabasco.

Javier attends seminary in the San Pablo Seminary in Merida, Yucatan, and his specialty is in Christian education. Our emphasis in counseling families is to attack the root of the evils that cause divisions in families, such as alcoholism, drugs, infidelity and violence. Email Request from Asbury Methodist Church

I am the pastor at Asbury United Methodist Church on SW 38th St here in OKC. We have a Children and Youth program on Thursday nights for the kids in the community. We average between 25-40 kids from K-12th grade, predominately hispanic. The kids are constantly battling the peer pressure of joining a gang and fighting is survival for them. We have about 80% boys and the rest girls. The purpose of the program is to provide a safe place for the kids to do homework, hang out and play games, do crafts, play basketball, four square, pool, etc. Our church is committed to the program but is an elderly congregation and we are having trouble getting enough volunteers to meet Safe Sanctuary requirements.

My question is, would St. Andrew's have a Sunday School class or other group that would be willing to partner with us and provide one or two young adults who would come on Thursdays and hang out with the kids and play with them? Our kids are good kids, but in need of positive Christian role models that will show them there is a different way of life than the gangs and streets.
