DA Good News

He is out of his mind! I thought he was the gardener. He is possessed by Beelzebub. He teaches as one with authority. Who is this man that even the wind and the waves obey him? He is John the Baptist or one of the prophets come back to life. Surely this man was the Son of God!

The most important question that we ever answer is "Who is Jesus?" All the above statements are recorded in the gospel accounts as people who saw and encountered Jesus tried to unfold the answer to the question. The conclusions that they reached prove that they are honest seekers of faith, committed disciples or unsuccessful discreditors. Yet Jesus has a question that all of us must answer: Who do you say that I am?

Perhaps you have encountered people who are not nervous when the subject of God is in conversation, but they have a stronger reaction when you bring up Jesus. It is one thing to think of a generic being and quite another to think of a person who lived, died, resurrected and ascended. Lent is a season of self denial and deeper inspection of our faith. Thus, we will attempt to go deeper into the consideration of Jesus and answering the question people asked and still ask, "Who is this man?" Maybe we will discover some answers to other questions that we have about the identity of the One Who is the Author of our faith.

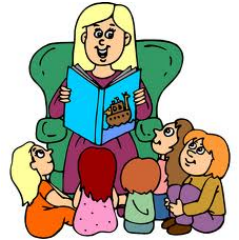
