Confirmation refers to the decision a person makes to respond to God's grace with intentional commitment, publicly reaffirming his or her baptismal vows before the congregation. During confirmation class, confirmands learn about the meaning of Christian faith; the history and teachings of the United Methodist Church; and an explanation of the baptismal and membership vows they will be professing. This speaks to the care the girls receive at Santa Julia and they are thankful for the part St. Andrew's plays in it.

Faith Promise Update

Last year we implemented a new (for us) missions support concept called "Faith Promise." Through this endeavor you evaluate your desire to make a financial commitment that will support missions, and then promise to fulfill that donation if God so blesses you. We've received over \$15,000 in Faith Promise contributions since opening the concept to the members of the church. The stories of how God helped the individuals meet their promises are very interesting. PREPARE THE WAY

For several weeks we prayed "LORD, what do you want to do through me?" as we considered our capital campaign. Perhaps you have wondered what the Lord is doing through us. Monies received through January 15, 2012, amount to \$107,658.50. This is truly amazing! This amount represents close to 10% of money that was pledged! This is what the Lord is doing through us!

And yet the news about what the Lord is doing is even more exciting! God is doing something we did not ask for, think about, consider as a group or join together as a prayer focus. But we are about to realize some great savings on our mortgage. Sooner State Bank offered to re-finance our mortgage. Our interest rate will decrease from 6.5% to 5%. That will save us a lot of money on interest payments and allow our principal to shrink faster. On top of that, the bank is paying all the cost involved in this refinancing - a savings of several thousand dollars. Our Finance Committee considered the offer carefully. And our Administrative Council approved it after a time of consideration and a time of prayer.
